**INVITATION - Workshop on 21 - 23 November 2012, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia:
“A Regional Perspective for Future Earth - Research for Global Sustainability”**

Further to our discussion by e-mail, this is the invitation to the Science Council of Japan (SCJ) to nominate a representative to the 3-day interactive workshop that will be held on 21-23 November 2012 at the Le Meridien Hotel in Kuala Lumpur to discuss Future Earth, a new 10-year research initiative on global sustainability. The nomination will be of a scientist from Japan who is already registered to attend the workshop (see list attached).

Launched at the Science and Technology forum in Rio last June, Future Earth is being established by a broad Science and Technology Alliance for Global sustainability including the International Council for Science (ICSU), the International Social Science Council (ISSC), the Belmont Forum of global change research funding agencies, the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), the United Nations University (UNU) and the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) as observer. The initiative will deliver solutions-oriented and integrated research on global environmental change and sustainability issues.

The workshop will bring together around 50 regional scientists working on global environmental change research from a range of disciplines, development agencies, educators and capacity building actors to discuss the priorities, success requirements and opportunities for Future Earth in the Asia-Pacific region.
