Dr. Motoko Kotani is the Executive Director of Science, RIKEN, and the Executive Vice President at Tohoku University, a professor at the Mathematical Institute, and the Principal Investigator at the Advanced Institute for Materials Research (AIMR). She won the 25th Saruhashi Prize for her contributions to Discrete Geometric Analysis on crystal lattices. She has held a number of executive positions, including RIKEN and the past presidency of the Mathematical Society of Japan. Currently, she is a Board of Governors of the Okinawa Institute of Science and Technology and the Science and Technology Co-Advisor to the Minister for Foreign Affairs. In addition, she is the Vice-President for Science and Society of the International Science Council.
