Masao Ogaki is Special Visiting Professor at the Faculty of Economics, Doshisha University, and Professor Emeritus of Keio University. He received his Ph.D. in Economics from the University of Chicago in 1988. After holding academic positions including Assistant Professor at the University of Rochester and Professor at The Ohio State University, he served as Professor of Economics at Keio University from 2009 to 2024. He has held his current position since April 2024.

He served as President of the Japanese Association for Behavioral Economics from 2015 to 2017 and as President of the Japanese Economic Association from 2021 to 2022. Since 2025, he has served as President of the Community Mechanism Research Association, and since 2024, as Chair of the Economics Committee of the Science Council of Japan.

His research spans behavioral economics, macroeconomics, econometrics, and the study of the community mechanism. He has published numerous articles in leading international journals, including American Economic Review, Econometrica, International Economic Review, Journal of Political Economy, and Review of Economic Studies. His books include Behavioral Economics: Toward a New Economics by Integration with Traditional Economics (Springer, 2017, co-authored).

同志社大学経済学部特別客員教授、慶應義塾大学名誉教授。1988 年、シカゴ大学経済学部博士課程修了 (Ph.D.)。ロチェスター大学助教授、オハイオ州立大学教授等を経て、2009 年から 2024 年まで慶應義塾大学経済学部教授を務め、2024 年 4 月より現職。2015 年から 2017 年まで行動経済学会会長、2021 年から 2022 年まで日本経済学会会長、2025 年より共同体メカニズム研究学会会長、2024 年より日本学術会議経済学委員会委員長。著書に『行動経済学——伝統的経済学との統合による新しい経済学を目指して〔新版〕』（2018 年、有斐閣、共著）などがある。学術論文を American Economic Review, Econometrica, International Economic Review, Journal of Political Economy, Review of Economic Studies 等に多数発表
