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His specializations are economic theory and computational social science. He graduated from the Faculty of Economics, Kyoto University, in 1989, and earned his Ph.D. in Economics from the University of Wisconsin–Madison in 1994. After serving as Assistant and Associate Professor in the Department of Economics at Stony Brook University (State University of New York) and as Associate Professor at the Research Institute for Economics and Business Administration (RIEB), Kobe University, he has been a Professor at RIEB since 2003. He served as Director of RIEB from April 2014 to March 2018, and has been Director of the Center for Computational Social Science since April 2018. He currently also heads Kobe University's Research Alliance for Future Urban Studies and serve as Vice President of the Society for Computational Social Science of Japan, President of IEFS-Japan, a Director of the Japanese Economic Association, and a Member of the Science Council of Japan. He is Editor-in-Chief of both the Journal of Computational Social Science and the International Journal of Economic Theory, and a member of the Executive Committee of the International Economic Association through June 2026. He received the Nakahara Prize from the Japanese Economic Association in 2010.
