MAIN ACTIONS AND PROGRESS

- 30 Sep 2019 – IRDR Coordination Committee in Geneva discussed the need of restructuring the global science agenda for DRR and resilience
- 22nd IRDR SC meeting decided to work on the new DRR Research Agenda as IRDR main task in 2020
- Jan-Feb 2020: a 3-pager for SC, NCs and ICoEs review and feedback, institutional mapping, timeline setting, SEI engagement
- March-May 2020:
 - ***The Guidance Document prepared to frame the development process***
 - ***Setting up and meetings of the Core Group members (drafting group)***
 - ***Literature review concept prepared***
- May-June: 2020: Setting up Expert Group for Review (In addition to IRDR, other DRR-relevant agencies and programmes, donors, networks, private sectors, policy research institutions, etc.)

OVERALL TIMELINE

- Early July: Expert Review Group meeting
- Mid of July: Completion of literature review
- Early August: First-order draft
- Mid October: Second-order draft
- 15 Nov: Final draft to ISC and UNDRR for review
- Final endorsement: IRDR 2021 Conference

During this period, online and off-line discussions, revisions and reviews.

- IRDR SC Members, IRDR NCs and ICoEs will be fully engaged in the process of this task.
- Input, advices and suggestions on both the Research Agenda and ways forward to carry out this task are warmly welcome.
